| M1 | <p>FORS documentation</p> <p>To manage, review, revise and retain all policies and procedures, risk assessments, method statements and supporting documents relevant to the FORS Standard.</p> | |
| M2 | <p>Records</p> <p>To manage and retain all records relevant to the FORS Standard.</p> | |
| M3 | <p>Responsible person</p> <p>To appoint a trained, experienced and (where necessary) qualified person responsible to run the fleet operation.</p> | |
| M4 | <p>Staff resources</p> <p>To provide adequate staff resources to run the fleet operation.</p> | |
| M5 | <p>Communication</p> <p>To communicate fleet management policies and procedures to all staff involved in the fleet operation.</p> | |
| M6 | <p>Vehicle fleet</p> <p>To document details of the vehicle fleet and how vehicles are distributed across the organisation.</p> | |
| M7 | <p>Regulatory licensing</p> <p>To hold all regulatory licences and permits relevant to the fleet operation.</p> | |
| M8 | <p>Health and safety</p> <p>To maintain safe and healthy working conditions.</p> | |
| M9 | <p>Complaints</p> <p>To review and act upon any complaint made against the fleet operation.</p> | |
| M10 | <p>Transport infringements</p> <p>To record, investigate and take action against all transport-related infringements.</p> | |

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| M11 | <p>Transport updates</p> <p>To keep up-to-date with developments in the fleet and road transport industry.</p> | |
| V1 | <p>Serviceability and roadworthiness</p> <p>To maintain vehicles, trailers and specialist equipment in a serviceable and roadworthy condition.</p> | |
| V2 | <p>Daily walkaround checks</p> <p>To check vehicles, trailers and specialist equipment for defects immediately before they are used.</p> | |
| V3 | <p>Insurance</p> <p>To hold a minimum of third party insurance or self-insurance for the fleet and any other insurance necessary to provide financial protection to the operation.</p> | |
| V4 | <p>Vehicle tax</p> <p>To tax all vehicles operating on public roads.</p> | |
| V5 | <p>Load safety</p> | |
| V5.1 | <p>Load safety for HGV</p> <p>To load vehicles and trailers safely and within the legal limits.</p> | |
| V5.2 | <p>Load safety for PCV</p> <p>To load vehicles and trailers safely and within the legal limits.</p> | |
| V5.3 | <p>Load safety for vans</p> <p>To load vehicles and trailers safely and within the legal limits.</p> | |
| V5.4 | <p>Load safety for cars</p> <p>To load vehicles and trailers safely and within the legal limits.</p> | |
| V5.5 | <p>Load safety for P2W</p> <p>To load vehicles safely and within the legal limits.</p> | |
| V6 | <p>Vehicle safety equipment</p> <p>To fit larger vehicles with safety equipment that helps protect vulnerable road users.</p> | |

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| V7 | <p>Tyre management</p> <p>To monitor tyre usage and maintain tyres in a serviceable and roadworthy condition.</p> | |
| D1 | <p>Licensing</p> <p>To verify that all drivers hold a valid licence for the category and type of vehicle they are tasked to drive and manage any risks associated with endorsements or restrictions.</p> | |
| D2 | <p>Driving standards</p> <p>To require all drivers to have knowledge of and comply with the rules of the road.</p> | |
| D3 | <p>Staff induction</p> <p>To inform drivers and other staff involved in the fleet operation of the fleet operation policies, procedures and FORS accreditation, from the start of their employment.</p> | |
| D4 | <p>Professional development</p> <p>To professionally develop drivers and all other staff involved in the fleet operation, through progressive FORS Professional Development.</p> | |
| D5 | <p>In-vehicle communication</p> <p>To not cause or permit a driver to use a hand-held mobile phone or any other hand-held communication device while driving.</p> | |
| D6 | <p>Health and eyesight</p> <p>To require that drivers are fit to drive, are not impaired and meet the minimum eyesight standard for driving.</p> | |
| D7 | <p>Working time and drivers' hours</p> <p>To manage drivers' working time and driving hours.</p> | |
| O1 | <p>Routing</p> <p>To adhere to compliant, safe and efficient routes.</p> | |
| O2 | <p>Fuel, emissions and air quality</p> <p>To monitor fuel consumption and vehicle emissions.</p> | |

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| O3 | Road traffic collisions To document and investigate road traffic collisions, incidents and near-misses. | |
| O4 | Passenger safety To carry passengers in such a manner that no danger is likely to be caused. | |
| O5 | Specialist operations To conduct specialist operations safely and in accordance with the law. | |
| O6 | Operational security To minimise the risk of theft of vehicles, fuel, equipment and loads. | |
| O7 | Counter terrorism To recognise the current terrorist threat and raise awareness, security and vigilance across the organisation. | |
